**Snowmobile Safety Course:** Operators of snowmobiles now have a convenient online method to receive Snowmobile Safety Certification through an Internet web course recently introduced by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. The internet course is available at [www.snowmobile-ed.com/wi](http://www.snowmobile-ed.com/wi). You must first obtain a DNR Identification number.
